COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION PRIORITIES + GOALS

Adapted from Phase 1 Outreach | December 1, 2015

The following priorities and goals were developed as a result of community outreach, which commenced in August 2015. Input was solicited from Western Addition residents at the Mo’Magic Annual Backpack Giveaway Event, Western Addition Sunday Streets, and the Mo’Magic Service Providers Meeting. Workshops included a path of travel exercise and survey to gather valuable information from the community on how to enhance transportation access and improve the transportation experience within the Western Addition. The project team received input from approximately two hundred community members during the initial phase of outreach. The priorities and goals below were a result of the first phase of community workshops and will continue to be defined with subsequent outreach.
