



Night Noise Notice August - September 2019

On four dates in August and September, the San Francisco Public Works will undertake brief **nighttime construction operations** on Townsend Street between 4th and 5th streets to support the San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) Townsend Corridor Improvement Project. The work includes construction of catch basins and associated maintenance holes.

Please note that the expected noise level for this part of the project is expected to range from the low to medium range. While this letter is a notice for potential night noise for this specific phase, SFMTA will continue to provide ongoing construction details through the project website: SFMTA.com/Townsend

During each of these four dates, there will be *non-continuous and intermittent night work*:

August 16, 2019

<u>Night Shift</u> 8:00pm to 7:00am Friday – Saturday

August 23, 2019

<u>Night Shift</u> 8:00pm to 7:00am Friday – Saturday

September 6, 2019

<u>Night Shift</u> 8:00pm to 7:00am Friday – Saturday

Construction of catch basins and maintenance holes on this date will occur on Townsend Street between 4th and 5th streets.

September 20th, 2019

<u>Night Shift</u> 8:00pm to 7:00am Friday – Saturday

Construction of catch basins and maintenance holes will occur on Townsend Street between 4th and 5th streets.





Project Information:

This construction is part of the SFMTA's Townsend Corridor Improvement Project which will bring new sidewalks, bus boarding islands, bicycle infrastructure and other safety enhancements along both sides of Townsend Street between 3rd and 8th streets.

Key Construction Update Information:

- Lane closures will be in effect during construction. Access will be maintained for public usage.
- Parking will be prohibited near work areas. Pay attention to temporary no parking signs.
- Some nighttime noise will occur during this period.

SFMTA and Public Works are maximizing construction during daylight hours, but occasional nighttime work is required. We appreciate your cooperation and understanding while we make the Townsend corridor safer for all users of the street.
