

# WIGGLE NEIGHBORHOOD GREEN CORRIDOR PROJECT

### PROJECT OVERVIEW

The San Francisco Public Utilities Commission, San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency and San Francisco Public Works are starting construction on the Wiggle Neighborhood Green Corridor Project this summer. The project is an effort to improve stormwater management and street safety conditions for all road users in the neighborhood. Improvements coming to the city's iconic "Wiggle" route were driven by a community outreach process in 2013 to 2014 and include:

- New curb ramps
- Pedestrian safety upgrades
- Landscaping
- Eco-friendly infrastructure



### CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

Construction will be from Summer 2017 to Winter 2017, with work happening 7 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday to Friday. Weekend work is allowed, but not anticipated at this point in time. San Francisco Public Works will be leading this work and will be your contact for any construction concerns. CF Contracting Inc. will be the project contractor. ### FUNDING

The construction cost of the Wiggle Neighborhood Green Corridor Project is approximately \$3 million. The project is funded by the Sewer System Improvement Program (SSIP), the 2011 Road Repaving and Street Safety Bond and Proposition K funds.

### TIMELINE

- Community outreach and planning: May 2013 to January 2014
- Environmental review: February 2014 to October 2015
- Engineering public hearing: April 3, 2015
- SFMTA Board of Directors approval: November 17, 2015
- Detailed design: Summer 2015 to Fall 2016
- Construction: Summer 2017 to Winter 2017
