# **Vision Zero Quick-Build Project Updates**

## **2024 Highlights**









This year was the tenth anniversary of San Francisco adopting a citywide Vision Zero policy in 2014, a commitment that has driven significant progress in improving traffic safety, including the launch of the Vision Zero Quick-Build Program in 2019, which has since installed over 50 miles of safety improvements on 40 corridors on the High-Injury Network.

Over five miles of improvements on six separate corridors were completed this year. In 2024, this effort was also complemented by the Quick-Build Toolkit Project, an initiative to ensure that safety improvements are installed at all 925 intersections of the High-Injury Network. Through this work, we installed daylighting at over 258 locations, among other safety treatments.

## **Next up for Approvals**

### Oak Street Quick-Build Project

The Oak Street Quick-Build Project is set for approval at the January 21 SFMTA Board Meeting. This project proposes several key improvements, including a new parking-protected bikeway on Oak Street between Baker Street and Golden Gate Park, the conversion of the existing bikeway into a protected bikeway on Baker Street between Oak Street and Fell Street, painted safety zones, and shortened crossing distances on Oak Street. The primary goals of the project are to enhance safety for pedestrians and cyclists, establish a new bike route, improve connections to and from the JFK Drive Promenade, and encourage safe vehicle speeds.

#### **Beach Street Quick-Build Project**

The Beach Street Quick-Build Project was approved at the December 17th, 2024 SFMTA Board of Directors meeting. In advance of street changes anticipated to be installed in Spring 2025, light-touch pedestrian safety treatments on Beach Street between Jones Street and The Embarcadero were completed this month. These improvements include upgraded crosswalks, advanced limit lines, and daylighting.
