Proposals Aim to Improve Muni & Traffic Circulation at West Portal Station

West Portal Station is a key node in the Muni rail network, where 3 lines (K, L and M) connect to the Twin Peaks Tunnel and the subway running beneath Market Street. Approximately 80,000 customers pass through this station each day. While there have been many upgrades to West Portal over the last 100 years, bottlenecks still persist regularly that can cause delays for Muni customers and detract from the experience of visiting West Portal. Along with planned operational improvements and following the completion of tunnel upgrades, the SFMTA is proposing new ideas to the area near the portal to improve transit, traffic circulation and pedestrian safety. This proposal is tentatively scheduled to go before the SFMTA Board on Tuesday, May 21.
