- Phases 1C and 1D scheduled summer 2019-summer 2021

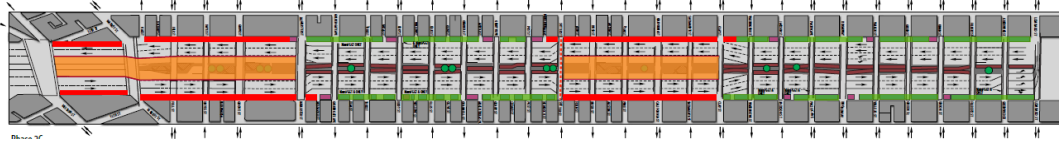
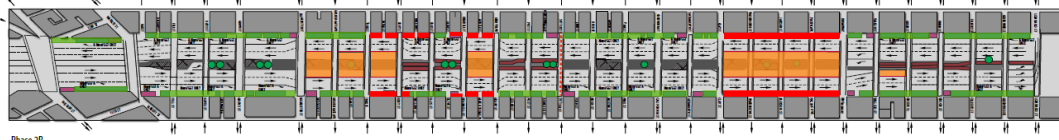
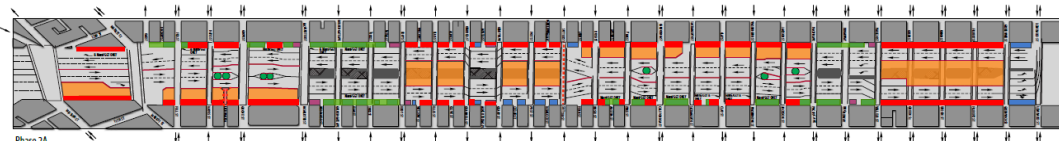

Geary Rapid Project

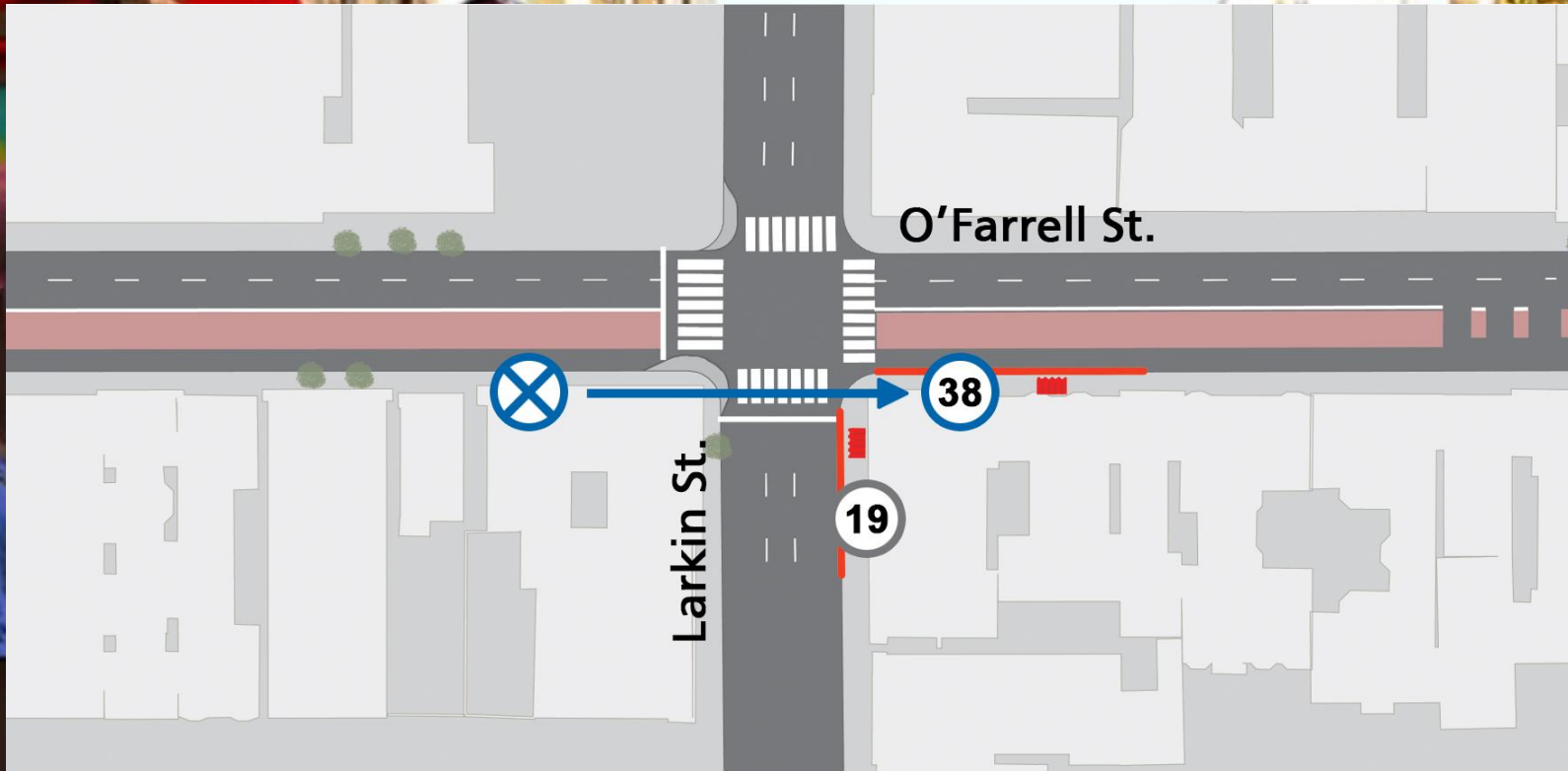
The first phase of construction as part of the [Geary Rapid Project](#) continues. Work to replace aging water and sewer lines between Masonic Street and Van Ness Avenue is scheduled to be done in coordination with the San Francisco Public Utilities Commission (SFPUC).

- Water main installation, connection and testing is planned for the week of October 28 on Geary Street between Van Ness and Hyde streets.
- Sidewalk and roadway work is planned for the week of October 21 at the south east corner of the intersection of O'Farrell and Larkin streets.
- Beginning Friday, October 25 the inbound 38 Geary bus stop at O'Farrell and Larkin streets will be permanently relocated to the east side of the intersection.
