Project Goals


- Improve access to shops and restaurants

- Support businesses






Outreach & Data Collection

- Inventory of curb usage within project area
- Video and in-person data collection to gather vehicle occupancy and duration data
- Surveys
 - Merchant 91 surveys
 - Resident 195 surveys
 - Intercept 82 surveys
- Two community open houses (September 26th & November 20th)
- Merchant and resident association meetings throughout project period





Proposed Changes

- Stop consolidation on Lincoln Way
 - Removing 7-Haight/Noriega stops at 7th and 11th Avenues
- Tow-away zone extension
 - Extend tow-away no stopping restriction from 4-6pm to 3-7pm
- Parking time limits
 - o Implement two-hour limit on Lincoln between 7th and 11th
- Bus zone extensions
 - Extend length of three bus zones to minimum standard

Previously Approved Changes

- Commercial loading
 - 13 new spaces, many relocated
- Short-term parking
 - 7 new spaces, reduced time limit, extended hours
- Passenger loading
 - 2 new dedicated spaces, three "dual-use" zones
- Accessible parking
 - 4 new spaces
- Visibility red zones
 - 7 new spaces, mostly on Lincoln (high-injury network)
- Tour bus zone
 - Weekends only
