BAYSHORE BOULEVARD QUICK-BUILD PROJECT



The Bayshore Boulevard Quick-Build Project brings new improvements on Bayshore Boulevard from Oakdale Avenue to Silver Avenue in Bayview-Hunters Point. Improvements include pedestrian painted safety zones to shorten pedestrian crossing times as well as parking protected and buffered bike lanes. These improvements will better safety and mobility for all travelers in Bayview-Hunters Point.

PROJECT DETAILS

Project Location

Bayshore Boulevard from Alemany Boulevard to Silver Avenue

Date of Implementation Fall 2023

Project Elements

- Upgraded some existing standard bike lanes into buffered bike lanes
- Upgraded some existing buffered bike lanes into parking protected bike lanes
- Installed new painted safety zones at key intersections to reduce vehicle turning speeds and increase pedestrian visibility
- Refreshed existing continental crosswalks with new paint

Key Evaluation Metrics

- Vehicle speeds and volumes
- Bike volumes at intersections
- Pedestrian volumes at intersections
- Duration of time that vehicles queuing for the car wash blocked the travel lane



PROJECT FINDINGS - AT A GLANCE



Vehicle Speeds

Typical weekday vehicle speeds on Bayshore Boulevard remained the same at 34 mph, slightly below the posted speed limit of 35 mph



Vehicle Volumes

Average weekday vehicle volumes remained the same on Bayshore Boulevard, with no major changes (1% growth, 14.9k vehicles to 15k vehicles)



Bicycle Volumes

Average bicycle volumes increased on the project corridor by 45% based on intersection counts



Pedestrian Volumes

Average pedestrian volumes on the corridor remained the same after implementation (9% increase, 52 pedestrians to 56 pedestrians)
